THE DAY AT A GLANCE

8:30 AM	Coach departs from your hotel.
9:00 – 10:45 AM	A leisurely walking tour (approx. 1.5–2 hours) through Bucharest's historic centre. <i>Highlights include the National Bank of Romania, the CEC Palace, the streets of the Old Town, Stavropoleos Church, the National Theatre, and Colţea Hospital.</i>
10:45 AM – 12:30 PM	Coach transfer to the “Prof. Dr. Nicolae Minovici” Museum of Popular Art, followed by a guided tour of its Romanian folk art collection and traditional interiors. <i>Construction of the neo-Romanian villa began in 1905 and was completed in 1906. Designed by architect Cristofi Cerchez for Dr. Nicolae Minovici, the forensic physician who founded Bucharest's ambulance service, it houses the folk costumes, textiles, ceramics, and glass icons he collected across Romania between 1900 and 1941. Decorative sculptor Wilhelm August von Becker later contributed to the design of the garden.</i> Please note: parts of the museum are accessible only by stairs. <u>Museum website: muzeulbucurestiului.ro</u>
1:00 PM	Lunch together at a restaurant near the museum.

GOOD TO KNOW

- ☞ Comfortable, sturdy walking shoes are warmly recommended. The morning tour is on foot, and parts of the museum are accessible only by stairs.
- ☞ October weather in Bucharest can be cool and changeable. A light coat or waterproof jacket is recommended.
- ☞ Participation fee: EUR 50 per person, including coach transfers, guided tours, and lunch.
- ☞ Coach transfers are provided between the hotel, city centre, museum, restaurant, and hotel.
